

The number of Muslims rose by almost 75% countrywide to a total 4.5 million in the decade between 2010 and 2020. New Jersey's Muslim population doubled over that time to more than 321,000. The largest increase in adherents among the religious bodies with the most congregants in the state were Hindu temples, with an increase of some 112% to more than 100,000 in 2020

### **General Election**

>Open to all <u>registered</u> voters

### **2024 Elections:**

- >US President
- ➤US Senate- 1 Senator


- Table, signs, banners. (<u>Download Here</u>)
- Make it attractive and visible!!
  - Clipboards and pens for folks who would like to fill the paper forms
  - Two or more laptops and internet access
    - ➤ Giveaways
    - >Set up in high traffic/high visibility area

### ON LINE VOTER REGISTRATION

- Online voter registration can be completed on the spot:
  - Register to Vote



#### What You Will Need

To register online, you will need your date of birth and one of the following forms of identification:

 A current and valid **Driver's License** or a non-driver **Identification Card** (ID card) issued by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC)

Your information will be provided to the MVC to validate identification, and to retrieve a copy of your digitized signature.

#### • A Social Security number

To use your social security number, you must have the ability to sign on-screen or upload your signature to complete the registration process. If you are unable to provide a digital signature, you can not register online. Click here to download the voter registration application for your county.

To protect your information, the application will time out after 5 minutes of inactivity, all data entered will be cleared, and you will be required to start over from the beginning.


### **FORMS**

- Print Forms
- County / State application: MS FOR DEMOCRACY
- Political Party Affiliation: https://www.nj.gov/state/elections/voter-party-affiliation-declaration.shtml
- ➤ Print as double-sided so easier to fold and mail
- ► Must be signed!!
- ► Tape to seal forms
- Clearly marked box for completed forms
- Ask people if they want to mail the form themselves or prefer you to mail it for them

# TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVE

- Do NOT endorse any candidate; 501c3 organization restriction
- Knowledgeable volunteers
- Know the rules and key dates
- Expect all kinds of questions: "Can I do an absentee ballot...?"
- Read thru NJ Division of Elections website: <a href="https://nj.gov/state/elections/vote.shtml">https://nj.gov/state/elections/vote.shtml</a>
- Male <u>and</u> female volunteers
- The 1% rule: Example, gathering of 300 people
- ➤ Expecting 200 men → Minimum 2 male volunteers
- ➤ Expecting 100 women → Minimum 1 female volunteer
- It takes time talking to each person, explaining the rules and walking them through the process
- >Attract those who may already be registered
  - >Change of address, name changes need to be re-registered

- It's not difficult to run a voter registration drive
- >AMD & NJMVP are here to help
- >Volunteers must be from the organization where the drive is being held
- Familiar with management, congregation and logistics
